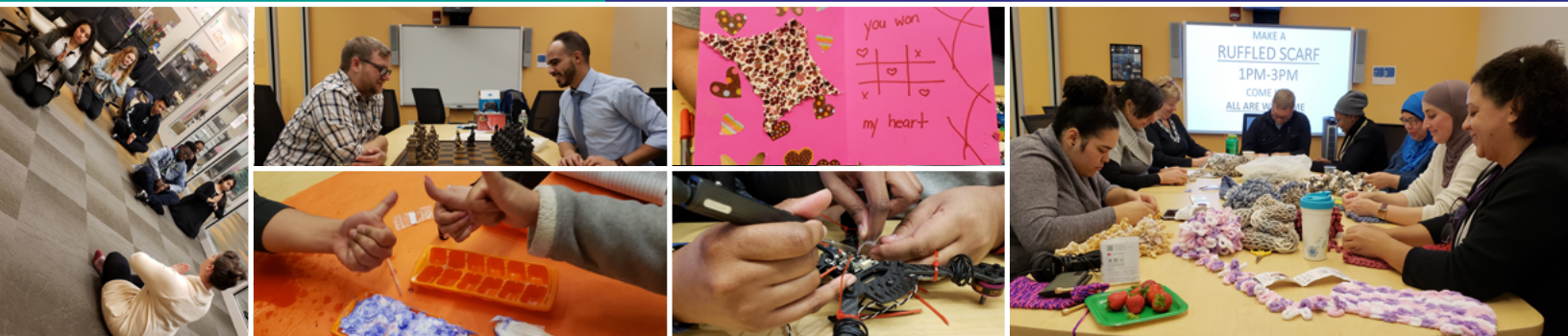


# Makerspace Events: Summer I and II 2019
